



Located at the foot of the Black Forest, <u>Freiburg</u> is nestled in the southwest corner of Germany near the Swiss and French borders.

The city can be reached easily by <u>train</u>. Discounted Deutsche Bahn train tickets are available <u>here</u> for our festival goers. Cheaper options include a <u>FlixBus/FlixTrain</u> connection or a ride via <u>blablacar</u>.

The closest airport is <u>EuroAirport</u> Basel/ Mulhouse. From there, you can take a <u>shuttle bus</u> to Freiburg central train station. Alternatively, train or bus connections from the Frankfurt and Zurich airports are also quite manageable.







Freiburg is a city of mad cyclists. It has a well established network of cycle paths and several bike-rental options (such as <u>Radstation</u> near the central train station or the public rental service <u>Frelo</u>). The nearest Frelo station is right next to the festival venue.

It is also very easy to get around by tram (<u>VAG</u>) or on foot.

Getting Around

Accommodation

We recommend booking your accommodation early. Affordable options include the <u>Black</u> <u>Forest Hostel</u> and the <u>DJH Youth Hostel</u>.

Outdoor enthusiasts can find camping sites not too far from the festival venue, including <u>Camping Möslepark</u> and <u>Camping Hirzberg</u>.

In addition, Freiburg has a lively Couchsurfing community and many <u>AirBnB</u> accommodations.

Many local students share their apartments during the festival week. Contact us via students@freiburger-filmforum.de and we will gladly put you in touch with one of them.


